	Top	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> MCSHB Navy dri-fit top, with school monogram. Trim should reflect house colour which student has been allocated to
	Shoes	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Sports shoes (only to be worn with sports uniform)
	Socks	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> White ankle socks
Optional Items	School Jacket	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> MCSHB Navy jacket with school monogram
	Winter Hats	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Navy beret or woollen cap

- The wearing of correct uniform at all times is insisted upon, summer uniform Terms 1 and 4, winter uniform Terms 2 and 3. Uniforms should be clean and tidy and well presented.
- No jewellery permitted. Only stud earrings are allowed to be worn. Hair is to be natural colour only.
- Long hair is to be kept tied back by the wearing of a blue or black hair tie. Nail polish is not allowed.
- Any under garments should not be seen under the uniform. Shorts for girls should be navy or black.
- Sports uniforms to be worn from Year 1 onwards.

Conclusion

- Failure to wear correct uniform will be followed up by a letter to parents.
- Persistent failure to wear correct uniform on the part of the student will result in disciplinary action.
- In compliance with Sun Smart campaign uniform sunhats are a compulsory part of school uniform. These are to be worn whenever outside by all students during the summer terms.
- Failure to wear sunhats will result in children sitting in the shade until they return to class.
